Driving Directions

From the west

Take the New York State Thruway to Batavia Exit 48; Route 63 South to Geneseo for approximately 20 miles; bear left at fork after traffic light (toward 20A); turn left at stop sign, onto 20A; first left at stop light onto Main Street (Route 39). Take the first left off Main Street onto Park Street; parking is available in lots B or C near Bailey Hall.

From the south

Take Route 390 North to Exit 7; Route 63/39 North (approximately 3 miles); turn left at the second traffic light onto Main Street (Route 39). Take the first left off Main Street onto Park Street; parking is available in lots B or C near Bailey Hall.

From the north or east

Take the New York State Thruway to Rochester Exit 46; Route 390 South to Geneseo Exit 8; Route 20A West (approximately five miles); turn right at the third traffic light onto Main Street (Route 39). Take the first left off Main Street onto Park Street; parking is available in lots B or C near Bailey Hall.
